## **IDENTITY THEFT AND CYBER CRIME:**

**Assistant U.S. Attorney General, Dean Eichelberger**

A simple definition of Cyber Crime is unlawful acts where the computer is either a tool or a target or both. This kind of activity usually involves a modification of a conventional crime by using computers. Some examples are financial crimes, cyber pornography, sale of illegal articles, online gambling, intellectual property crimes, and identity theft. The scope of Cyber Crimes increases from our growing dependence on computers in both our professional and personal transactions.
